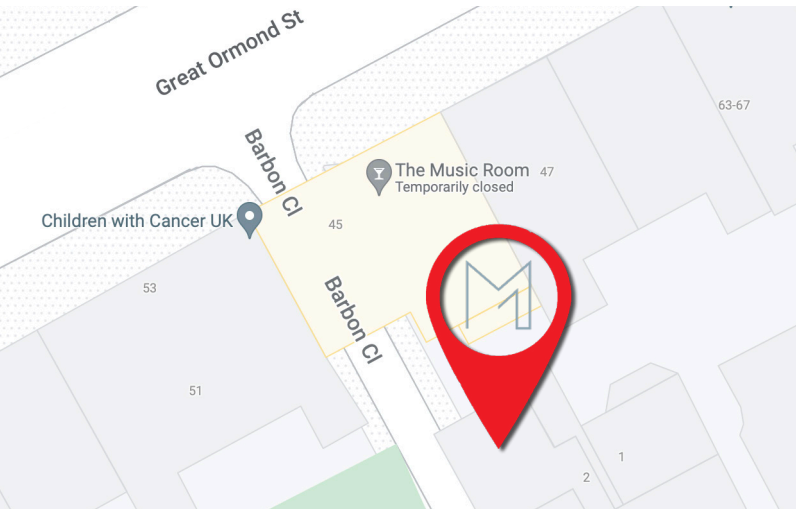




It's official - we have moved!
